

## **NADTC - Championship Agility Show 2010 COMPETITOR INFORMATION**

**14 DAY RULE** – Anyone who has won out of a grade at least 25 days before the start of the show should have notified the show secretary at least 14 days before the show (Rule 15 in schedule) Any competitor who has not done so will **not** be allowed to change entries at the show, they will not be allowed to run and there will be no refunds.

**RINGS & TANNOY** - There will be tannoy announcements during the weekend. Remember that it is **your** responsibility to be at the rings in order to run a class and in the correct running order. Please note Classes marked with \* on your ring cards are first in ring

Please be courteous to anyone working on a ring they are all volunteers! **Anyone** reported for being rude or insulting to ring party may be asked to leave the show. Anyone found interfering with the tannoy system will be asked to leave the show.

**EXERCISE AREAS** - The main area is adjacent to the day parking. There is an outer walkway that circles the entire venue. **Please be aware the outer perimeter electric fence is live!** This **cannot** be turned off as it forms part of the farm's main circuit and ensures the safety of their animals. There is a long offsite walk along the public bridal way/footpath, which can be found midway along the top edge of the walkway. Other suggestions for offsite walks can be found at the Secretary's marquee.

Please be considerate to others when exercising your dogs and keep them under control. All dogs must be on lead outside of the exercise areas. **Clean up after your dogs in ALL areas of the venue. Anyone seen not to be cleaning up after their dogs will be asked to leave the show!**

**FENCING** – **Do not climb any fences** as this can cause damage. Anyone found doing so may be asked to leave the show.

**CAMPING** - Camping pitches have been allocated and will be dealt with on arrival.

Keep within your designated pitch. **Keep all roadways clear** and arrange your caravan/tent, awning and caravans as instructed. **Do not** set up any personal training equipment.

**FIRE EXTINGUISHERS** - All Camping units should have a fire extinguisher and/or a bucket of water, which is clearly accessible in the event of fire. Fire points will be positioned around the venue, please familiarise yourself with their locations.

**DAY PARKING** - Please park as directed. Ensure dogs have adequate shade, ventilation and water. **Do not** set up any personal training equipment.

**TOILETS** - Portaloo toilets will be situated around the venue. A disabled portaloo will be situated near the Secretary's Marquee. If any toilet is discovered

to be missing toilet rolls or in an unusable state please inform the show manager.

**ELSAN**- Tanks for emptying chemical toilets will be provided. Please **DO NOT** wash out chemical toilets using the water taps provided for drinking water!

**RUBBISH/LITTER** - Please help keep the venue tidy and free from litter. Large bins will be provided around the show for disposal of rubbish and poop bags. Please do not over fill the bins – if one is full please use another.

**TRADE STANDS** - There will be a number of trade stands offering goods and services throughout the weekend, so please support them.

**REFRESHMENT** – Sticky Fingers and an Ice cream van will be on site throughout the weekend.

**LOCAL SHOPS** - A Co-op, Chemist, Newsagent, Late-Stop convenience store and Chinese takeaway can be found in Collingham village. Turn right out of the venue and approximately 1 mile up the road.

Newark has Waitrose, Aldi and Morrisons supermarkets along with McDonalds, KFC, Chinese/Indian takeaways and numerous fish and chip shops. Turn left out of the venue and then at the roundabout turn right and follow signs to Newark Town Centre.

Calor Gas and spares/accessories for caravans/motor homes can be obtained from Brownhills Leisure World. Follow directions to Newark Town Centre as above and it is situated opposite the McDonalds / KFC.

Directions to any of the above can be obtained at the Secretary's Marquee.
